



Incident Brief

It's a frosty winters day. You and some friends have gone for a walk out in a local park. You hear shouts for help coming from the direction of the park pond and you run towards them. This is what you find...

Casualties

Casualty 4 has walked out onto an ice sheet to fetch a football. The ice has broken underneath the casualty and they have subsequently fallen into the pond and disappeared under the ice. When their friend doesn't reappear casualty 1 and 2 both proceed out onto the ice leaving casualty 3 on the side. When they arrive at the broken section of ice casualty 1 jumps into the freezing water and swims under the water to try and find casualty 4. When arriving back at the surface they are out of breath and struggling to breath and grab onto the ice where casualty 2 is standing. The ice again breaks throwing casualty 2 into the water as well. Upon resurfacing casualty 2 struggles to hold casualty 1 up out of the water who is now having breathing problems. During this whole incident casualty 3 (stood on the side) shouts for help. The 4 rescuers hear the shouting and then arrive on the scene as there is one casualty under the water and two struggling to keep above the surface.

NOTE: Rescuers can only spend 30 seconds in the pool before they too become a casualty due to the water being so cold.
